

New ICWA Notice

A new Indian Child Welfare Act (ICWA) notice has been implemented to help caseworkers track required ICWA data in the person record for foster children on open SCF cases. Notice #69 will inform workers of one of two situations.

1. The child has an ethnicity of Am Indian/Alaska Native, but does not a tribe name entered into the tribe data field.
2. The child has a tribe name entered in the tribe data field, but does not have an ethnicity of Am Indian/ Alaska Native chosen.

If either situation exists, the caseworker should question the family to determine if an ethnicity of Am Indian/Alaska Native exists and if tribal information is missing. If the child is Am Indian/Alaska Native, they should obtain the correct tribe information and enter the data into SAFE on the general tab of the person record. At this time only a tribe name is being required, however workers should ensure that the correct tribe has been notified and the other data fields have been filled out correctly. In order to be in compliance with the Indian Child Welfare Act, all foster children on open SCF cases should have this information filled out in its entirety.

The worker can Dbl click or Right click on this notice to navigate to the person record.
